 - We are \$1200.00 over budget for grooming. Tim thought supplemental would be about \$.50 on the \$1.00. We need to be careful about trail maintenance money until June.
- Mary Lou Bergman discussed the problem of Highway “T” and ATV trails which Cozy Corner is having and Gordon. She would like some help to address the issue and feels the more groups involved, the better to get something done at the county level. Members of our club will meet with Cozy Corner after their May 3rd meeting to discuss ideas. Bernie suggested that the Town's Association may also be able to add support for these trails.
- Mary Lou also asked for some volunteers to help with the 5K Run on July 5th in Gordon – a sheet was sent around for names.
- Mary had Food and Fun tickets to look over – they will be ready for the next meeting.

- Howard asked the club to donate for fertilizer for the ball park again this year – about \$200.00. Motion by Charles/second by Willard. Motion carried.
- Do we still want to put a planter around the base of the flag pole? Motion by Mary/second by Jean to go ahead with it. Motion carried.
- Road clean-up after the next meeting on May 17th. I didn't realize we had another Saturday in May and planned the meeting for a week before Memorial Day as usual; it will stay the same.
- Ideas for projects: bathroom in the building, expansion of building if we get another groomer, fix bleachers. The consensus was for year-round water lines if we do a bathroom.
- Jon thought we should invite Lance to attend a meeting to discuss a Youth Fishing event.
- ATV class will be June 6 and 7. We will need treats for Friday night and Saturday morning.
