Old Business

- Crystal Lake Campground thanked the club for the donation to their Easter egg hunt.
- Snowmobile/ATV Trails are closed and signs will be posted. Road routes remain open.
- Summer raffle tickets have been ordered and will be distributed within the next few weeks.
- The next meeting will be changed to 5/21/11 due to the holiday weekend on a Jon/Dick motion.
- Patti will order posters for Food and Fun. Charles will reserve the beer wagon.
- Tour of Businesses – A Dick/Mick motion was passed to pay for soup and snacks for the Tour of Businesses up to a \$50 limit. A Mark/Willard motion was passed to give 3 gift certificates, valued at \$25 each, from Wascott Tourism as prizes throughout the day to attendees of the Tour of Businesses.
- We will need to put together team(s) for the Minute to Win It contest on May 14. Anyone interested in participating should contact a board member or arrive at the event before noon on 5/14.
- The club has not received any new requests for road openings. There has been a petition circulated to be presented to the Town to close the Bass Lake Road route. Patti drafted a letter on behalf of the club in support of keeping the route open.
- Open House/ATV /Poker Run has been scheduled for July 9. All non-members participating will be eligible for a 1 year free membership. Businesses that are interested in participating will be asked to donate a door prize of approximately \$20 value.
- New fund raising ideas for Food and Fun are being sought.
- Dick discussed the possibility of webcams with Greg Jensen. Among other things, there would need to be a dedicated telephone line for each camera. Due to the potential cost, this won't be feasible.

New Business

- The club received a check in the amount of \$310 from Ski Doo for the Ski Doo Million Dollar Club program.
- Tim reported that AWCS has signed a 3 year contract with Discover Wisconsin

to promote snowmobiling. Commercial members will have an opportunity to be interviewed and the promos will air locally on Channel 10.

- Mark applied for state funding for Trail 3.
- Trail work needs to be done this spring. We will either need to repair the bridge or reroute the trail.
- Debbie reported trash pickup will start. She also sent a sympathy card to a club member.
- Road clean up has been scheduled for May 21, 2011 after the next meeting.
- Mark Schroeder asked for a receipt for the Recreational Parking which Patti will provide.
- Need to decide if we will be scheduling an ATV class. Minong is also discussing holding a class, so if they have a class, it won't be necessary for us to have one also.
- The recent town election resulted in some new board members being elected. The club will work with the town in an effort to resume work on the ball park.
- The Music in the Park event that was going to be held in September at the ball park has been cancelled as the promoter has lost his largest sponsor. If he is able to find a new sponsor, the event may be rescheduled. This is on the agenda for the Town board meeting for Tuesday.
