Secretary's Report was approved as read on a Mic/Loren motion.

Treasurer's Report was approved as read on a Tim/Mike motion.

Bills and Correspondence

- Doris purchased 4 easy up tents for the club for Food and Fun. A Deb/Marlene motion passed to purchase the 4 tents as well as an additional 4 if available at the same price.
- Get-Er-Done Club forwarded a letter that the Barnstormers Club wrote to the Wisconsin DOT expressing concern over plowed roads. Apparently the DOT in Northwestern WI requires that all roads that receive gas tax funding be plowed regardless if they are used by vehicles in the winter. Many of these rural roads in the Barnes area are snowmobile trails. As a result of the plowing, snowmobilers were unable to travel to Barnes. They have asked that we share the letter and have club members express their support by drafting their own letters to the addressees shown.
- Received a letter from Douglas County Special Olympics requesting a donation. A Dick/Loren motion passed to donate \$30.

Old Business

- Mark made a brief presentation at the town meeting on behalf of the club sharing our community involvement during the past year.
- Our Open House is scheduled for 7/12. Posters should be delivered this week.
- Youth turkey hunt is 5/15.
- Business Appreciation was successful. We had 31 people attending and sold club clothing. Mike was the winner of the poker run.
- Need to move the raffle board for the fishing trip.

New Business

- Road cleanup is scheduled for 5/31 after the meeting.
- Cap/Step program was signed into law to be effective 07/01/15. Snowmobiles will be required to purchase a 3 year registration for \$30 and an annual trail pass. If you are a club member, the trail pass is \$10 per year. If you are not a member of a club, the trail pass is \$30 per year. An out of state trail pass is \$50 per year. All money from the trail pass will go to supplemental funding for trail grooming.
- A lot of trail signs are down from the heavy snow this winter. Several new posts were purchased and a work day has been scheduled for 05/10 to install them. Anyone available to help is asked to meet at the club building at 10 a.m. on 5/10.
- Meat Raffle: 5/3 Mark and Dick; 5/17 Hansons
- Terry has an ATV with tracks and would like a clarification of the definition of a vehicle that is legal for trail use. He hasn't been able to get a definite response from the DNR. Tim will see if he can get a satisfactory answer from the DNR.

- Jon has been contact by a new company interested in supplying the kids amusement rides for Food and Fun. He will get prices and verify that they will do the set up and supply workers to operate the rides. Mark will do the same for Doucette's.

- Need to start collecting door prizes. Jon suggested one big door prize drawing at the end of the day in which you would need to be present to win.
- Raffle tickets and door prize tickets have been printed. Raffle tickets need to be distributed for sale. If anyone would like some books to sell, please contact a board member.
