  - Let Mark Schroeder know if we do any work on Chipmunk trail, like fixing the corners.
  - Trail Maintenance dinner is on May 12<sup>th</sup>, let Tim know if you would like to go.
  - Diane Conklin will be replacing \_\_\_\_\_? with DNR.
  - Cut a Way Dam will get a new bridge this year.
  - Pokegema Bridge is still being looked at.
  - We need more than one person in each club to do maintenance billing and fill out forms.
  - AWSC will discuss moving host from DNR to Dept. of Tourism at July meeting. This could be an advantage.

### New Business

- Howard would like \$150.00 to fertilize and seed at ballpark. Motion by Charles, second by Mark. Motion carried.
- The parking lot at the ballpark will be paved soon.
- ATV maps will be out by Memorial Day.
- Flea Market: Brats and hot dogs at 9:00.
- Food and Fun tickets will be the same as last year. We need to save tickets after a raffle for one year now.
- It was decided to form a ball park improvement committee to come up with a list of ideas by priority – possibly bleachers and benches.
