Chuck has volunteered to survey the current signs to determine what updates are needed as well as additional informational signs. - Bob talked with the town supervisor and suggested they extend the blacktop at the corner of Cranberry Lake Road and Crystal Lake Road to prevent washout at the corner. They agreed it would be helpful and will be including for the next road maintenance.
