

## **December 4, 2010 - 4 Seasons Recreational Club Monthly Meeting**

Secretary's report was approved as read on a Mark/Mick motion.

Treasurer's report was approved as read on a Mark/Mick motion.

### **Old Business**

- Thank you to Crystal Lake Bar, View Point Bar & Grill, and Golden Chipmunk Grill, Bar & Resort for their donations and continued support.
- Trails are not open. Dick and Mark did some clearing and should finish soon.
- A service tech from Lulich Implement will come to Wascott to show members how to service the tractor. This first service call is included with the purchase of the tractor, however the club will be responsible for the cost of fluids, supplies, etc.
- Wreaths have been sent to landowners and the last few will be delivered today.
- Winter raffle tickets have been distributed. All members are encouraged to help sell tickets. Contact a board member if you would like a book of tickets to sell.
- The town has a land use agreement from the county for the Recreational Parking area. It is on the agenda to be discussed at the town meeting on Tuesday.
- Doris reviewed the insurance policy and discussed coverage with our agent. It appears there are several liability exclusions and limitations. Tim suggested checking with a couple of other companies that provide insurance for snowmobile clubs. Due to the time frame involved, a Bob/Mick motion was passed to authorize Doris to research and make the decision to purchase an insurance policy that provides adequate coverage for the club.
- Mark delivered 45 certificates for the Ski Doo Million Dollar Club to the Ski Doo dealer in Webb Lake. We should be receiving \$450 for the promotion.

### **New Business**

- Tim reported that the AWSC canceled the trail use survey. They will refine the survey and conduct next year.
- Washburn County trails will open on December 13 after the T-zone hunt. Douglas County will notify the clubs when trails open.
- Tim reported that the bridge near Danbury has experienced some deterioration, so a 1000 lb weight limit has been implemented. As a result, the trail across the bridge will not be groomed this year.
- It was suggested at the last meeting that the treasurers' report be included in the minutes. A few years ago it was reported that the IRS did website searches and several clubs were taxed based on the balance that was reported. As a result, the AWSC recommended that this information not be posted on websites. The information is available to all club members upon request and is reported at each meeting.
- Gift wrapping for the Childrens' Christmas Party will be held on 12/18/2010 at the town hall.
- Doug Bush announced that he will be running for town supervisor and he would appreciate anyone that would be interested in signing his nomination form.
- Gordon Winterfest will be held on January 29. They are collecting donations for the construction of a basketball court and tennis court. Bob/Chuck motion was made to donate \$100. Dick amended the motion to donate \$200 which was seconded by Mark. Motion passed to donate \$200.

- Mark has reserved a block of 10 rooms at The Lodge in Siren for the club ride on February 12-13. Anyone interested in attending will need to reserve your room before January 12 by calling 877-843-5634. Cost per room is \$109/night based on double occupancy.
- Logostich was sold to Imagine It Embroidery. It appears prices are the same, but service may not be. Deb will continue to work with new owner as well as check into options for other suppliers.
- Mark suggested the club buy a chainsaw to have on the tractor. Cost will be about \$340. Tim has a coupon for \$35 off the purchase of a Stihl product that he will donate. A Tim/Bob motion passed to purchase a chain saw and case. Jon mentioned that we will also need to purchase a box for the drag to carry extra, signs, equipment, parts, etc.
- A trail near Barnes has been rerouted, and nearly all the trails through Gordon have been rerouted to get them off the roads.
- Debbie was notified of the passing of a former club member. It was discussed and decided that, in order to maintain consistency, we will continue to send memorials/cards to current members and relatives as outlined at a previous meeting.
- Bob announced that the Wascott Tourism and Development Association is having a poker run from December 17-January 30 with 8 stops. Participation is appreciated.
