Old Business

- It was agreed that the membership drive/ATV ride would be tabled until next year to allow adequate time to plan.
- We were unable to do road clean up in the spring, so we will plan a date in the fall.
- Thank you to Wayne for making and donating the poker wheel to the club.

New Business

- AWSE did not have a meeting this month. Mark will be requesting winter funding for the trail from the Stop-A-Sec to the Chipmunk.
- There will be another Minute to Win It event. This is tentatively scheduled for 10/29/11. A letter will be sent to the other clubs inviting them to participate.
- The price of a commercial membership increased to \$40.00
- Gordon Gun Range has asked if they could set up a table and sell tickets for their fund raiser at Food and Fun. A Don/Mark motion passed that they could sell tickets if they agreed to purchase a membership to the 4 Seasons Rec Club.

- Food and Fun – We will use the tickets we have. Reviewed raffle boards from last year and eliminated duplicating the items that didn't sell out. Need more door prizes and paddle wheel prizes.
- Jon will talk to Charles about getting an amp to go with the new speakers that were purchased last year.
