Old Business

- Bill reported trails are in good condition now that we have our new drag back. Lulich Implement, where we purchased the drag, had borrowed it for a few weeks to take to a show in NY to demo. When they returned it, they also donated \$100 to the club. Chuck asked about the box drag, and we will keep it as a backup.
- The trail reroute is scheduled to be done by Haawkinsons at the end of August. In the meantime, we need to remove some of the smaller trees.
- Jon knows someone in his campground that wants the shed. We will need to clean it out and he will move it. Mark did the paperwork to get the permit and has scheduled delivery of the new shed for August 1.
- Thank you to Jon and Bill for tilling and applying lime to the ball park. A machinery part broke that will have to be replaced. We still need to rake out the grass and apply fertilizer.
- Road clean up was done after the last meeting. Thank you to all who volunteered.
- Jack had reworked the club logo after suggestions from the last meeting. A Dennis/Mike motion passed to accept the new logo with 2 opposed. Doris will order 1000 can koozies with the logo. Koozies with be blue with white print.
- Jon talked to the town rec committee about reroofing the buildings at the park. Apparently the maintenance committee is responsible, so Chuck will talk to Bob. In addition to reroof, the restroom door is damaged and needs to be replaced and we should have new lights inside the restrooms.
- Jon suggested we put up a fence along Marshall Road as there are dirt bikes going around the gate to access the trail that is closed.
- A Marlene/Deb motion passed to pay Colleen \$50 for the flowers she planted in the flag pole garden.

New Business

- Food and Fun – Deb ordered more volunteer shirts and money tickets. We received a price for cooked beef and pork from Dan. We agreed to try 60 lbs each of shredded pork and shredded beef. I will ask for samples for the next meeting. Mark will call for a 3yrd-4yd dumpster. We need raffle board items and door prizes. All members are asked to starting collecting these items. Deb and Colleen volunteered to purchase pop.
- Some of our long time volunteers have announced that they will not be able to help at Food and Fun this year, so we will need new volunteers to fill the void. Anyone interested in helping, please let me know so

we are sure to have enough people. We need ticket sellers, food servers, order takers, raffle boards, etc. People can volunteer for the afternoon or just a couple of hours. Everyone is needed and welcome.
