- Discussed Food and Fun and took suggestions for changes and improvements to consider implementing for next year. Doris will compile a list for review while planning next year's event.
- Wascott/Gordon EMS was present during Food and Fun to be available in the

event of an emergency. A Debbie/Dolly motion was passed to donate \$100 to the EMS.

- Based on door prize tickets, FNF attendance was approximately 834.
- We sold 432 raffle tickets. There was a \$100 winner awarded by mistake. Prizes should be 1-\$500, 1-\$300, 1-\$200, and 20-\$25 for a total of \$1,500. Jean suggested that we use the same color each year for raffle tickets.
- We had a \$100 gift certificate from the Stop A Sec for a raffle board that wasn't used. A Debbie/Don motion was passed to donate it back to the club to use for tractor fuel.
- Doris will send a thank you note to Sony for the corn.
- The trail ride that was scheduled for after the meeting was canceled due to lack of participation.
- A Willard/Mark motion was passed to pay Crystal Lake Bar \$147.75 for FNF supplies and business appreciation.
