- Road clean up was canceled due to the rain. It has been tentatively rescheduled to be done after the October meeting provided the weather cooperates.
- Mark asked for ideas for new projects. Jean suggested an informational sign to be posted on the outhouse. Jon will get bids for gravel for the trails. Chuck suggested an addition to the building for a meeting room. The shed at the ball park needs to be replaced. Bob has a building that he offered to donate to the club.

New Business

- A club ATV ride has been scheduled for October 12. The ride will leave from Stop-A-Sec at 10 am. Riders can travel by ATV or car. The ride will go to Trego with stops along the way. Bring snacks to share on the trail. Everyone is welcome so extend the invitation to friends and family.
